The Ministry of Health announced on 3 Apr 2020 that they will introduce an elevated set of safe distancing measures to act as a “circuit breaker” to curb the increasing local transmission of COVID-19. Workplace premises should be closed, and business activities continued via telecommuting. These measures will be in place from 7 April 2020 until 4 May 2020 (inclusive).
